## **Guidelines for manuscript submission to the journal *Water Resources Management* Special Issue from the 10<sup>th</sup> World Congress of EWRA in Athens**

Dear author(s),

Your paper presented in the 10<sup>th</sup> World Congress of EWRA was among those selected for submission in the special issue of the journal *Water Resources Management*. The submission deadline is **30<sup>th</sup> of November, 2017.**

All articles should be submitted online, using the journal online submission system <https://www.editorialmanager.com/warm>. Authors should make sure to indicate that the article is submitted for publication in the Special Issue "EWRA2017" in the accompanying cover letter and the appropriate pull-down menu.

Please, follow the rules below:

- 1) The title of the article has to be different than the original title submitted to the Congress.
- 2) The material of the article -including text, Tables and Figures- needs to be significantly different than the original article. As an indication, we ask authors to modify their article by at least 50% before submitting it for possible publication.
- 3) The original paper submitted to the 10<sup>th</sup> EWRA Congress should be cited in your manuscript.
- 4) In the paper there should exist the following acknowledgment: *A previous shorter version of the paper has been presented in the 10<sup>th</sup> World Congress of EWRA "Panta Rei" Athens, Greece, 5-9 July 2017.*
- 5) Please follow the guidelines of the journal in preparing your article ([http://www.springer.com/earth+sciences+and+geography/hydrogeology/journal/11269?detailsPage=pltcI\\_2057908](http://www.springer.com/earth+sciences+and+geography/hydrogeology/journal/11269?detailsPage=pltcI_2057908)).
- 6) Six possible international reviewers, who have completed work in the same subject, need to be proposed during submission. Proposed reviewers should not be members of your Institute or University.
